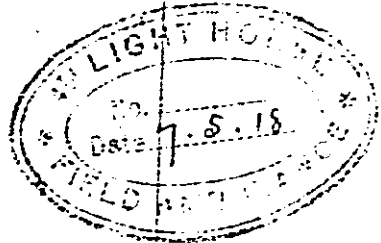

	4th Light Horse Field Ambulance	19378	Private ARTHUR JOHN WESTON	On 4.5.18 at the last position taken up by the Brigade, which defended the road to ESAULT he was sent with a message to Brigade Headquarters. While returning he found a dangerously wounded man in an exposed position. He immediately went to him and after great difficulty helped him on to his own horse. He then ran and led the horse for nearly a mile under shell and heavy machine gun fire. He eventually reached the Ambulance in a condition of collapse. It was an act of great gallantry and won the admiration of all ranks.
