At DERNANCOURT S.W. of ALBERT, on 28th March, 1918, the enemy had succeeded in gaining the front line and were spreading out to gain the flank posts. This Officer who had been inspecting gun positions, at once charged the enemy, killing one Officer and three men and drove the remainder back where they were taken prisoners.

He wrested a Machine Gun from the enemy ^{gunner} and used it to effect on the retiring enemy.

His prompt action largely assisted in the defeat of the enemy's attack and kept our line intact.

He was wounded early in the action but remained on duty.
