Private Reginald BURTON. Private BURTON was acting as lineman while the Battalion was in the HINDENBURG LINE, near BULLECCURT, FRANCE on 4th.—Sth.May 1917. During this time he, in company with another lineman, who was afterwards killed, laid a wire to the front line (0.6.2) and kept it going under very heavy shell fire on the three days mentioned. He repeatedly run the line under an intense enemy barrage until he was badly wounded. His fine work undoubtedly contributed to the success of the operations and his work has been consistently good throughout.
