At BULLECOURT, France, on the night 6/7th May, 1917, during the bombing attack in the Hindenburg Line, Pte. CUBBINS worked throughout, carrying out the duties of Stretcher Bearer, under extremely heavy shell fire, he also attended wounded under a heavy barrage when it appeared impossible to line in the trenches. His coolness and devotion to duty was the means of saving many lives for he continually carried the wounded in and placed them under cover.

At BULLECOURT, France, on the night 6/7th May 1917, during a successful bombing attack in the Hindenburg Line, Cpl. WALLIS showed distinguished conduct and devotion to duty. He led his Lewis Gun Section into action with great dash and determination in the face of heavy artillery and machine gun fire. He worked his gun and gave covering fire to the attacking bombers; this assisted greatly in capturing the trench. He also successfully engaged hostile machine guns and did splendid work in the forward posts, on many occasions wiping out parties of Germans moving up to reinforce. He showed great initiative and skilfully controlled his Section throughout the engagement.
