CUEBIES worked throughout, carryDivision. ing out the duties of Stretcher Bearer, under extremely heavy shell fire, he also attended wounded under a heavy barrage when it appeared impossible to line in the tranches. His coolness and devotion to duty was the means of saving many lives for he continually carried the wounded in and placed thom under cover.

9th Battalion 2242 Opl. Charles WALLIS

At BULLECOURT, France, on the night 6/7th May May, 1917, during a successful bombing attack I in the Hindenburg Line, Cpl. WALLIS shewed I distinguished conduct and devotion to duty. He led him Lewis Cum Section into action with great dosh and determination in the face of heavy artillery and machine gum fire. He worked his gum and gave covering fire to the attacking bombers; this assisted greatly in capturing the trench. He also successfully engaged hostile machine gums and did splendid work in the forward posts, on many occasions wiping out parties of Germans moving up to reinforce. He sheed great initiative and skilfully controlled his Section throughout the engagement.
