The Levis Gun in Lieut. GRAMM's sector was buried and his erest became casualties. At great personal risk he dug out his gun and repaired is. Still under heavy shell fire he instructed a new erest in firing the gun and in loading magazines. By this means he was able to keep his gun in action and use it during the infantry attack of the energy.

By his determination, great personal courage, and control, he inspired the son in his line with the result that although the enemy had captured the whole of 0.0.1 they were neverable to approach his sector of 0.0.8.

This is attributed to his cheerfulness and unflinching devotion to duty.
