On the nights of the 19th and 20th July 1916, and subsequently he personally led many rescue parties into "NO MAN'S LAND" to recover wounded men and salvage although continually sniped at with rifle and machine gun fire. On transfer to the 60th Battalion he devoted himself with great energy and ability to reorganising the remnants of the Battalion and owing to the shortage of Officers has remained continually in the firing line since that time to supervise the works being carried on there. I cannot speak too highly of his services in this respect which resulted in a vast amount of work being carried out by his Battalion whilst in the trenches.
