	31st Batt AIF		LIEUTENANT. LESLIE NORMAN. LARNACH.	<p>During the attack of the 31st Batt. from WARFOSEE - HOBANCOURT. on the 8/8/19 this officer displayed great initiative and bravery. He worked his platoon to great advantage and cleared up several tactical situations which had arisen. On working at the BLUE LINE, he received a nasty shell wound in the neck but refused to leave the line, the pieces of shell being extracted by a fellow officer. On the 9.8.19 he advanced with his company under a heavy shell, MG. and rifle fire and occupied a position 1000 yds. in front of the original line. He moved about encouraging his men while they were digging in. In the course of this operation he was seriously wounded in the back and was carried to the rear.
