	3 rd Bn. A.I.F.		Captain Cyril Douglas SAVAGE.	<p>For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during the operations of 26/27th August which resulted in the capture of FOUCAUCOURT. This Officer was in charge of the left Coy. of the attack. His careful dispositions and tactical handling of his company was responsible for the rapid advance and out-flanking of the enemy. At one time when his right flank was held up and no Officer in charge of the platoon, he went forward under very heavy artillery and machine gun fire and personally directed and led the platoon and so enabled his right flank to keep touch with the Company on his right. At another time when his centre was held up, he arranged for artillery support which effectively dealt with the opposition. His careful handling of his company was mainly responsible for the smallness of his casualties. His utter disregard of danger was a great incentive to his company.
