F.	2738	Private (Lance- Corporal) John REGAN	<p>For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during the operations of the 26/28th Augt. which resulted in the capture of FOUCAUCOURT, and our line being advanced beyond ESTREES.</p> <p>This man led a section of the support Coy. skilfully and with determination throughout the operations. On the 27th August his Platoon went forward to re-inforce the front line, and there he shewed good leadership and bold action which greatly assisted the advance.</p> <p>On the 28th, prior to the 31st Bn. moving through this Unit, he led a reconnoitring patrol out under heavy machine gun fire and obtained information for that Unit. His boldness of action, and determination carried him through, and he was successful in obtaining reliable information of the exact position of the point of resistance, and numbers of enemy holding same, which information was of great value to the advancing troops.
