These three mem of D. Co. 3rd Bn. who formed part of the section which reinforced the R.M.L.I. a few minutes prior to the trenche being evacuated most pluckily remained behind in the trench succouring four wounded men. They collected them from various parts of the trench into the lower end, which they deepened for safety. So assistance could be rendered them all day. Constant messages were sent for stretcher-bearers during the ensuing night but owing to tactical reasons it could not be rendered. They remained in this precarious situation until nightfall on Honday, 3rd May. One had meanwhile its succembed to his injuries. The conduct of the men was most creditable.
