At POLYGON WOOD near HOOGE from the 28th.September to 1st.October 1917 the Pill-box was under heavy shell fire. Captain Woods had to treat all stretcher cases in the open which he did with great courage. His arrangements for getting extra men as stretcher bearers from Battalion at the right moment and his untiring energy undoubtedly saved many lives.
