September 1917 to the present time No. 1153 Driver Norman GATLING has done particularly good work in taking ammunition to the guns under very trying circumstances. On the night of the 3/4th. November 1917 this Driver was one of the party packing ammunition. There was heavy shelling and one of the party was wounded ; this Driver took the wounded man to a dressing station and then continued packing, using his own two horses and the two horses of the wounded man in addition. He did four trips, the ammunition being packed, being special smoke shell urgently required.
