During the silent p notration of the enemy lines on the afternoon of 9th July 1918, at HOMEFUT WOOD, near VILLERS HEETOHEUX, Pto WEISACK was first beyonet can of the Night assault party. After the entry, he led the way along the enemy trench for 300 yeards, showing a conspicuous lack of fear, and billing three of the oneny. At points where the enony was net, his determination was such as to owne partie among them. The flight of superior mmbers of the encry is attributed very considerably to his resolute attitude and close pursuit. His contempt for danger undoubtedly encouraged his conrados, and very largely attributed to the final and complete success of the operation. This men was efterwards wounded in a reconneissance of a sap leading to the enemy's Support Lines.
