During the attack on the 9th August 1918 South of FRAIEWILLE, near Allens, this non's Company mot with heavy casualties. He was acting as stretcher bearer. Time seer time he went out bendaging and carrying wounded men under a heavy enemy barrage of shell and machino gun fire, and it was mainly through his efforts that the whole of the wounded on his sector were cleared before nightfall.

During the attack on the norming of the 11th August 1918, South of FRAMERVILLE, moor MITERS, this N.C.O. was out on the telephone lines for nearly four hours, monding and repairing the line back to Brigade H.Q. the time his work was carried out under a heavy onemy barrage of sholl and machine gum fire, and it was by his offorts alone that commication was maintained between forward Battalion H.Q. and Brigade H.Q. during the operations.
