During the attack on HONT ST. QUENTIN, near PERIGUEUX, on 31st August 1918, this officer showed great leadership in keeping his platoon under control until the objective had been reached, and then he greatly assisted in clearing the village under very heavy machine gun and rifle fire.

He was a tower of strength in dealing with the numerous counter attacks by the enemy during the remainder of the day, instilling great confidence in the men under his command, who under adverse circumstances had to bring onto very serious and important positions.
