"During the attack on MT ST QUENTIN North of PERONNE on 1st September 1918 portion of the Company to which this Warrant Officer belongs were prevented from reaching their objective by the vigorous fire of a strong party of the enemy with two machine guns.

C.S.M. Trevascus dashed forward, followed by two men, and attacked them with bombs. They drove the enemy from their position and the remainder of the party reached their objective.

This W.O. then took charge of the consolidation of the position which he reorganised in a most excellent manner.

His daring and ability in handling men were of a very high order throughout the operation, and it was owing to his prompt action that the guns on this strong post were put out of action and captured."
