For his valuable services from the 22nd September to the 12th October, 1917, during the operations east of YPRES, when, after his Company Commander had become a casualty, he took control of the work in hand and carried it through successfully in spite of heavy enemy fire. Also for his work in the MESSINES-YPRESCHAEDE Sector from 31st January to 24th February, 1918, where he displayed exceptional ability in the construction of reinforced concrete works, some of which were erected under direct observation of the enemy. Lieut. MILLER displayed such ability in screening the construction of these works that they were completed without interruption by the enemy. He has, at all times, set a splendid example to officers and men in overcoming difficulties, and all his duties have been carried out in a cheerful and efficient manner.	C.O., 1st Aust.
