During attack on CREPEY WOOD and afterwards in capturing the hospital he and Pte. McDermott between them killed 6 of the enemy, took 3 prisoners and 2 machine guns. His work throughout was admirable.			
	Tenth Australian Infantry Battalion.	7533	Private, <u>Henry James McDERMOTT.</u>	For gallant conduct and conspicuous bravery in operations near LIHONS on 10/12th. August. During attack on CREPEY WOOD and afterwards in capturing the hospital he and Pte. Carruthers between them killed 6 of the enemy, took 3 prisoners and 2 machine guns. His work throughout was admirable.			
	Tenth Australian Infantry Battalion.	3477	Private, <u>John Thomas DAVIES.</u>	During operations near LIHONS on 10/12th. August this stretcher bearer, with Pte. Bott, worked continuously for 36 hours. They were the only two left, the other bearers having been wounded, and carried on without assistance. Almost every casualty in the company was evacuated through them and when all the wounded were evacuated these two bearers removed all the killed.			
	Tenth Australian Infantry Battalion.	6546	Private, <u>Joseph MARTIN.</u>	For gallant conduct and conspicuous bravery in operations before LIHONS on 10/12th. August. He displayed great initiative, particularly in the fierce fighting in CREPEY WOOD, when most of his platoon became casualties. His conduct throughout was admirable.
