While the Battery position was under a heavy bombardment of Gas and H.E. during the night 28/29 March 1918, this gunner went backwards and forwards through the shelling, dressing wounded and attending to men who were gassed, performing his duties with admirable coolness and disregard for personal danger.</p> <p>At about 1 a.m. he came down and dressed a man of another unit, close to where the shells were falling. Later when the fire lifted on to Battery position, Gun. Daly went straight through the heavy shelling and spent a considerable time in an atmosphere of gas bandaging wounded and attending to gas cases.</p> <p>By his conduct and coolness and devotion to duty he set a splendid example to his unit.</p>	<p>LIEUT.
