PRESENTATION OF DECORATIONS BY THE CORPS COMMANDER.

1. The Corps Commander will present Military Medals awarded to members of the Third Australian Division, at 2-30 p.m. on Saturday, 7th instant.

2. A Parade will be held at HILLSIDE CAMP (T.14.d.3.8) and the following representative troops will parade :-

5. DRESS: Marching Order, Officers will be dressed like the men; Australian Headdress will be worn; Steel helmets on the back of pack. No officer or man will be mounted. All personnel will be fully equipped and special care taken that all ranks have colour patches. The mess tin will be worn on top of the pack.

Troops will report in the ground at 2-0 p.m.

Right markers will report to the D.A.A.G., at 1-45 p.m.

Recipients will parade at 1-45 p.m.

6. The troops will be formed in a hollow square, recipients in the centre.
