L/Opl. FREDLEY, after his Officer and H.G. Coy. Sergeant had become casualties, took charge of and re-organised his section under very heavy shell fire. He explaced his guns to great advantage in GLZHCORSE WOOD. On 21st Sept. when his officer became a casualty he took charge of the Section. On this day two guns were blown in by shell-fire and were rordered useless; these he dug out at great personal risk and reported the situation to his G.O. and berrowed and emplaced 2 German Guns captured by 10th Battalion. Throughout the operation he displayed great initiative and courage and set a fire example of devotion to duty to the men of his Section.
