His arrangements for dealing with stragglers during an action and for policing dangerous and prohibited areas, with special reference to the capture by the Division of BOURSIES, DEMICOURT and HERMES near BULLECOURT on 8th April, 1917 were excellent. During the recent operations east of YPRES including the successful attack of the Division on 20th September 1917 he was in charge of Divisional Control and Stragglers posts with his headquarters in a much shelled area. He was largely instrumental in reorganising scattered parties, prisoners, stretcher bearers with wounded, etc., and maintaining order on a main route.
