Lieut., Dodd was in charge of No. 1 gun, 3th battery, which was detailed to attack three <del>xxx</del> small enemy works at a range of 1100 yards. Owing to the proximity of our own trenches direct laying had to be used, and the parapet of the gun spaulment had to be reduced. The Detachment knew that they would come under fire at the first round, but carried out the duty and remained in action for 16 mins. Lieut Dodd, besides commanding his gun, acted as No. 1., and behaved most gallantly. He was wounded by artillery fire, which caused the gun to cease fire after accomplishing the object.
