On making a third trip Pte.BENT obtained several panniers of machine  $\vdash$ gun ammunition which had been lost on the way ដ្ឋ across. His conduct throughout was extremely 601; 5th cool and his bearing inspiced the remainder of the men. The above has not been recommended in the King's Birthday Honours List.
