

South of MALESHEV on night 26/27th July, 1918      C.C. Bar to  
Corporal HAMMERSLEY was in charge of a fighting 12th. Bn. M.L.  
patrol of 1 R.G.C. and 10 men sent to obtain  
identification. Having located a post, he led his  
men towards a flank leaving a covering party a  
few yards in rear. The post was found to be  
strongly held, and in rushing it Corporal HAMMER-  
SELY was wounded. He continued to direct operat-  
ions until 10 of the enemy were killed and iden-  
tification obtained. In returning he found that a  
party of the enemy had moved from a flanking post  
and were cutting off his retreat. A fight ensued  
in which more of the enemy were killed. It was  
his strong personality and disregard for his own  
safety that made the patrol a success.
