At great personal risk Pte.ROBERTS pushed forward over 40 yards under heavy fire, and from a flank engaged the post while Cpl.WALTERS and Pte.ROBINS crept along and bombed the position. The skill and courage of Pte.ROBERTS enabled the post to be approached and bombed and the Machine Gun and garrison of the post captured.
