	26th Bn. A.I.F.	1832	PC (S/Bearer) B.L. SCOLYER (Killed)	For exceptional devotion to duty and courage in his work during the attack on POZIERES RIDGE - 4/5th August 1916 and the period following. He worked ceaselessly for 48 hours, during the whole of which time he was exposed to heavy shell fire. He was killed by an enemy shell at TARA HILL on the night the Unit was relieved in the trenches.	<i>For the 7th A.I.F. Brigade.</i>	Mention in Despatches	
		577	Sergeant J. BROOKS-BALL. (Killed)	For gallantry as leader of his platoon during the attack on POZIERES RIDGE on the night of 28/29th July 1916. He led his men to the wire in front of the German Trenches and was killed in looking for an entrance through it.		do.	/
		2452	Sergeant G.T. ROBERTSON.	After the troops had withdrawn from the enemy position on the night of 28/29th July he volunteered to go back in search of one of the Coy. Lewis Guns which had been left behind. He succeeded in recovering same but was killed just as he was on the point of re-entering our line.		do.	/
