## THE MILITARY CROSS (Contd)

2nd Lieut. Arthur James SHEPHERD. 55th Battery. Australian Artillery.

At DICKE BUSH on the 28th May 1917, in a Howitzer Battery position in the open which was being heavily shelled by 8" and 5'9" howitzer, this Officer took command of and personally assisted a party of volunteers who localised and put out a fire of N.C.T. cartridges thereby preventing an explosion of heavy howitzer shell and consequent damage to equiptment and 1 as of life. This Officer has at all times shown gallantry and devotion to duty regardless of personal risk.
