

17th No 1861 Sapper GLARE, L.E. "For gallantry, invaluable services, and devotion to duty, whilst under heavy fire!"
 This Sapper did 6 trips, with important reports & sketches, from "Strong Point" at "LONE HOUSE" during our operations of 20th & 22nd / 9/17 against the vicinity of Polygone Wood. His total runs aggregated about 20 miles, being the 6 trips back & return to O.C. Field Coy at HOOGE CRATER. All was done with cool judgement and great gallantry throughout several enemy barrages. He set a splendid example.

15th No 2582 Sapper CARTER, W. "For gallantry and devotion to duty under heavy fire!" This Spr. did 6 or 7 trips with important messages & sketches from "Strong Point" at South corner of Polygone Wood to O.C. Field Coy. in HOOGE CRATER (a total mileage of 25). This he carried out under the most dangerous conditions of enemy barrage fire. Throughout the whole operation he displayed remarkable courage & skill.

16th No 406. Lance Corp. WALLACE, G.H. "For great gallantry and splendid devotion to duty under heavy fire!"
 This N.C.P. was employed on the supervision of a party during the construction of a "Strong Point" at "LONE HOUSE" during our operations against Polygone Wood. He carried out these duties in a remarkably able & gallant manner, and when his officer and another corporal, were hit he went out to try to assist them in the face of deadly fire. The Officer and Corporal were however dead, so Lieut Wallace brought back their papers etc, and later, getting assistance he buried them both and marked the spot. He was a splendid example of devotion to duty throughout dangerous operations.
