This N.C.O. during the whole of our preparations for recent offensive continued night after night to conduct R.E. Waggon conveying material & personnel from YPRES to HOOGE, and return at daylight with the working parties. On every trip he had to conduct his waggon thro' heavy shelling of the roads, and displayed remarkably cool judgement in so doing thus avoiding many casualties. His horses were several times hit by fragments of H.E. Shells.
