ADKINS, Theodore William.	Lance Corpl.	145	2nd Fd. Co. Engrs	Amazons 25th April to 19th Dec., 1915.	Lance Corpl. Adkins landed with the 2nd Fd. Co., A.E., on 25th April 1915. He was shot through the shoulder soon after the landing and after having his wound dressed, persuaded the Medical Authorities to allow him to remain on the Peninsular. He then did excellent work on the mapping of the trenches supervised by his Co. In the attack on Lone Pine he did good work in assisting to bomb the enemy out of positions of importance. In the evacuation he at once requested that he be allowed to remain to the last as one of the demolition party. Permission was granted and he carried out his part of the work very efficiently, demolishing a 5" howitzer on the right flank. His age is 45 years.	3	40
