(Sheet 62 D.) Tpy. 2nd. Cpl. CURROW after preliminary reconnaissance through St. MARTINS Wood during its capture was despatched to the rear to bring up waiting <del>and</del> wiring and carrying parties. His skill and judgment in bringing parties through heavy artillery barrage and H.G. fire no doubt lessened casualties. He was of invaluable assistance in reconnoitring the position and his coolness and disregard of danger under heavy shelling and H.G. fire were admirable and a fine example to his party. On night of 24th. instant while in charge of carrying parties he again demonstrated his disregard for personal safety in the carrying out of his duty and his fine <del>example</del> conduct inspired confidence in his men.
