During the operations east of YPRES on 4th. October 1917, he was one of a party employed on the construction of a strong point in the vicinity of MOLENAARELSTHOEK. He gave great assistance to his section officer in locating and setting out the work. On proceeding to the work, owing to heavy machine gun fire, it was necessary to take the working party across the ridge in small parties and on four occasions he crossed leading the parties, and setting them to work. Throughout the whole day he did splendid work supervising and his confident bearing greatly encouraged the men.
