While at YPRES (under most difficult and dangerous conditions) he succeeded in getting a portion of front line trench, which had been badly damaged by shell fire, into a most satisfactory condition. At GUEUDECOURT he was in charge of the work of digging an assembly and jumping-off trench for a proposed attack. On the trench coming under heavy shell fire he displayed great courage, and rendered much assistance in bringing in the wounded.</p> <p>On one occasion, during the absence of the senior N.C.O.'s, he acted as Company Sergeant Major, and discharged his duties in a most competent manner.</p>	G.O.C. 1st.
