During the operation near PORYART on Aug. 23rd, 1918, Sgt. PRESTON showed great bravery and devotion to duty. He is the Picheer Sergt. of his Battalion and employed his section with great advantage under heavy shell fire. By nightfall on 24th instant he had collected the bodies of all members of the Battalion who had been killed in the previous day's action, had croasses and graves prepared and the bodies properly interned. Throughout the pariod the Battalion was holding the line he showed great devotion to duty in collecting captured enomy machine guns, trench mortars, etc. and securing their return to the rear.
