Although in a very exposed position and being heavily bombed by the enemy, he stuck to his gun and beat down the opposition with it in fine style. Throughout the advance, he rendered his Coy great assistance by pushing forward singlehanded with his gun and holding the enemy down while they advanced.</p> <p>He set a splendid example of courage and initiative throughout the attack.</p>	<p>Smithell H. Harry Dudley CARRUTHERS	<p>For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty during the attack on HERLEVILLE WOOD on the 23rd August, 1918.</p> <p>L/Corp CARRUTHERS was a member of a Lewis Gun team all the members of which became casualties early in the advance, he, himself, being gassed. He stuck to his gun and advanced with it, singlehanded, rendering his Coy. invaluable aid by holding down the enemy until the final objective was reached when he collapsed.</p> <p>Throughout the advance, though suffering severely, he showed indomitable courage and set a splendid example to his comrades.</p>	<p>Smithell H.
