Captain ERIC WILLIAM TULLOCH.	<p>Near CHUIGNOLLES, FRANCE, on the 23rd August, 1918, Captain TULLOCH was in charge of two Companies of the 11th Battalion who were detailed to outflank and capture FROISSY BEACON.</p> <p>Throughout the whole operation (which owing to the precipitous nature of the country was beset with difficulties and dangers) this Officer evinced tactical instincts of a very high order.</p> <p>With brilliant dash and admirable courage repeatedly he led his men under galling machine gun fire against enemy positions, outflanking and overcoming the enemy's resistance, till the objective was gained.</p> <p>His great gallantry, coolness and tenacity inspired all about him, and to him must be attributed the greater measure of the success of this operation.</p>	CO 11th Bn
