Bde. by collection of reports from Forward Observation Officer and by close Limisan with the Battalian Commander enabled a closer support of his Artillery Brigade to be given to the Infantry. His Limisan work assisted the advance materially. He greatly encouraged his man and set them a fine example under heavy shell and machine pun fire.

loist Houston Battory, Austoralian Field Artillery. Lioutenant Frederick Falvey DRAME.

At ESTRES on 28th Aug., 1918 Lieut. DRAKE, C.O. M.C. in the absence of his Bettery Captain, took let Aust. charge of the Bettery on the wounding of his F.A. Bde. Hajor and most ably directed the fire while under heavy enemy shell fire.

On 20th Aug., 1918 he brilliantly led his Battery to a forward position near VILLERS CARBONNEL under heavy fire and most effectively dealt with enemy gues and Infantry.

By his coolness and judgment he set a brilliant example to all ranks under him.
