F.	7103	Lance Corporal Robert Scott BEATTY MM	During the advance from JEANCOURT on 18-9-18, Lance Corporal BEATTY followed by his section, rushed a machine gun nest in a small quarry, and despite heavy rifle and machine gun fire, he advanced, firing his Lewis Gun from the hip. He succeeded in putting one of the enemy gun crew out of action and swept the parapet of trench. Having ordered six prisoners to the rear, he then handed his Lewis Gun over to his section, and armed with bombs and a revolver alone mopped up the remaining enemy in the quarry. His total captures from this quarry were 3 Officers, 45 other ranks, and 3 machine guns. During the whole of the operation he handled his gun and section with wonderful skill, daring, and coolness.			
	10th Battn. A. I. F.	1587	Sergeant John Clifford WICKHAM	During the advance from JEANCOURT on 18-9-18 Sergeant WICKHAM'S platoon met strong opposition from an enemy post in a quarry. Leaving his Lewis guns to occupy the attention of the enemy post, he moved round the flank and succeeded in bombing the enemy out of the post, thus enabling the entire garrison to be captured and the advance to be continued. His daring, bombing skill, and initiative alone made this possible.		MM
