On April 13th when the Division took up a position at STRAZEELE for the defence of HAZE-BROUCK, Major McKILLOP organised and established Aid Posts and Relay Posts with great rapidity, regardless of the fact that the enemy were attacking strongly the whole time. From this time on he was in charge of the Advanced Dressing Station and did excellent work organising bearers for the many minor operations under heavy shell and machine gun fire.</p> <p>By his excellent organisation the wounded were removed from the forward area with great rapidity. His work has, at all times, been marked by great devotion to duty and by his personal disregard of danger he has set an excellent example to all ranks.</p> <p><i>J.W.
