September 1918 to cessation of hostilities on 11th. Nov. 1918 private HAMILTON has served continuously with this battalion. On September the 18th. 1918, when his company participated in the operations in front of JEAN COURT, it was his company's work to get dummy tanks forward and on to the tape line. This work had to be done under trying circumstances.
