This Sergeant has rendered consistently gallant service, especially during the final Allied Advance from Villers Brettoneux on August 8th 1918 to cessation of hostilities. Particularly during operations for the capture of Mont St Quentin on August 31st 1918, this Non Commissioned Officer displayed conspicuous bravery in bringing forward his wagons to the guns at a time when ammunition was urgently needed. No less than three separate journeys, covering many miles, were undertaken successfully through enemy barrage. During the month of June 1918, at Villers Brettoneux, this Non-Commissioned Officer served with his Battery in Liason with the French Troops.		Medal Militaire
