	6th Battalion, Australian Imperial Force.	2143	Corporal Peter MARONEY.	Cpl. MARONEY was a member of a party of 2 Officers and 4 other Ranks which raided an enemy post near HERRIS in daylight on 8th July 1918. He crawled out in advance of the raiding party and gave covering fire for 2 of his Officers who were creeping out to raid the post. To get a better field of fire he stood upright in the crop regardless of his own personal safety and singlehanded engaged an adjacent enemy post with rifle fire. He succeeded in keeping the enemy in this post at bay until his officers had raided the other post, captured the occupants, and brought them back as prisoners to our lines.
