The 13th Battalion was relieved in that position on night of 11th/12th July . Lieut. Boocard went out for his final patrol that night, and received a danger ous wound from machine gun cullets. This Officer was dangerously wounded in AUSTRALIA VALLEY, AFZAC, in August last year doing similar work. He is of French parentage, but born and educated in England and has rendered post excellent service. He will, in all proba ility, he unfitted for further service owing to his second wound.
