February to night 16th/17th. September Major CAMERON has shown the greatest courage and resource in the handling of his Battalion.</p> <p>At VILLERS BRETONNEUX on the 24th. April when the Commanding Officer and a large portion of the staff of the Battalion had become casualties, and the enemy had attacked and broken through our line, Major CAMERON was placed in charge of the Battalion and after a personal reconnaissance of the position, formed a flank with his Battalion, thereby saving the situation.</p> <p>He had charge of the Battalion during the trying times in April and at MORLANCOURT later on, when his skilful and courageous handling of his Battalion was again marked.</p> <p>His conduct throughout has been worthy of the highest praise.</p>	<p><i>J.
