On August 28th., 1918, during the opera-  
tions East of HAMEL this Officer commanded a  
platoon.

When a section of 9 men with whom he was  
working was held up by an enemy Machine Gun  
post covering an Observation post, Lieut. ROB-  
ERTS brought his Lewis Gun into action and with  
4 men worked round the flank, and rushed the  
post, capturing 5 prisoners here and 6 others  
from a dugout in rear.

Throughout the operations Lieut. ROBERTS  
displayed much bravery and devotion to duty.
