He assisted greatly in the protection of the left flank which was in the air. He maintained continual liaison with the flank of the front line battalion and by his skilful handling of his company and his appreciation of the situation he largely contributed to the standing firm of the left Battalion front, and to the defeat of the enemy's counter-attack. -

His courage, determination and ability to command men was freely displayed during the operations and he set a fine example of cheerfulness and endurance to his men. -

This Officer was awarded the MILITARY CROSS in May, 1918. -
