JAMES led his platoon with great gallantry and skill. - Although the enemy line was strongly held by machine guns which caused many casualties among his men, he succeeded in reaching his objective and capturing 30 prisoners. - Throughout the consolidation his men were subject to heavy machine gun and rifle fire, and it was only by his courage, cheerful disposition and total disregard of danger that the consolidation was completed successfully. - His fine example, great gallantry and devotion to duty was an inspiration to all ranks and contributed largely to the success of the operation. -	(Sgd) W.
