He then attended to the This performance was -otiler three cases. carried out under very heavy shell fire. lie had then to hasten forward under very heavy shell fire to rejoin his company. services as a stretcher bemer sere called for, he was always ready and several times declied forward under heavy machine gun fire regardless of any perconal danger. Company was forced to withdraw to avoid total onvelopment, his assistance in getting back the wounded was displayed under very trying circumstances when the machine gun and rifle His determination. fire was intense. Tearlennness and devotion to duty on this occasion were all that could be desired. The effects of his example are quite marked mong his fellow-men.
